

Atayal Adventure 4 Realms

Creative Motivation



The indigenous peoples have lived in Taiwan for thousands of years and are part of its rich and diverse culture. Today's educational curriculum **not only strongly promotes local languages** but also encourages individuals with indigenous identity to obtain native language certifications through various benefits and incentives.

However, **the number of students choosing indigenous language courses in each school remains very low**, and since 2017, **the certification pass rate for indigenous languages has been below 50%**. This highlights that the promotion and recognition of indigenous language proficiency still need improvement.

To address this issue, our team has designed a board game incorporating NFC technology to **enhance interactivity**. Additionally, we created an Atayal-themed board game, language learning cards, and a tribal language book in **hopes that players can improve their language skills through gameplay and increase the pass rate for indigenous language certification**.
